Dance Common, Cricklade, Wiltshire

Dance Common is registered as Common Land but has no registered owner. Currently it is in a very neglected state, and I have on several occasions over the last few years approached the Cricklade Town Council to do something about it. Whilst the Council has certain responsibilities to prevent acts detrimental to common land, it has no maintenance duties.

However the Council has agreed in principal to support my forming an interest group for the Common. This group plans to consult with the community and other interested parties in order to formulate a management strategy and, subject to agreement from the Town Council and appropriate authorities, seek to raise funds and carry out maintenance work.

I believe you may have an interest in what we might propose to do in managing Dance Common, and to that end I invite you to become a member of the group. If you wish to be represented on the Management Committee of the group, and to attend our meetings as and when appropriate, please let me know.
