What Do You Know About Dance Common?

Where is it?

The main part of Dance Common is the approximately 50m wide strip of land on the left (east side) of the Purton Road immediately after you leave the built-up area of Cricklade, which extends for about 500m.

Who Owns it?

Dance Common is registered as Common Land but has no registered owner.

Who is Responsible for Maintaining it?

Nobody has responsibility for maintaining Dance Common.

The Future of the Common is in the Hands of the Community

The Town Council has agreed in principal to support the forming of an interest group to decide the future of the Common. It is important that any management plan reflects the wishes of the local community. We are, therefore, looking for responses from individuals who are concerned about Dance Common.
